

C. C. Dickinson Family Giving Circle Criteria and Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Be a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization as designated by the IRS
- Provide services within Boone, Clay, Fayette, Greenbrier, Kanawha, Lincoln, Logan, Putnam, or Raleigh counties

USE OF FUNDS

Annual grant awards will be up to \$50,000 in the following categories:

Conservation and/or Education - Grant funds may be used for the following activities:

- The development of a natural learning environment for children with learning disabilities or children in marginalized communities.
- Training for teachers/tutors on the educational needs of students with learning disabilities
- Provide opportunities for children from marginalized communities to experience nature and learn the importance of conservation

Women Transitioning out of Substance Abuse Treatment - Grant funds may be used for the following activities:

- Mentorship programs to help women with their transition back into the community
- Provide resources in job training/placement, housing, and/or childcare
- Individual and/or family counseling for the women and their families following treatment

PROCESS

- October 15, 2019 is the deadline for applications that shall be submitted via The Greater Kanawha Valley Foundation's online application system – www.tgkvf.org/special-initiatives/C.C.Dickinson-Family-Giving-Circle
- Only one application per organization is allowable.
- The C.C. Dickinson Family Giving Circle Grant Committee will review applications and announce grant awards by December 2019.
- All grantees will be required to submit an interim and final report outlining their activities, outputs, outcomes, and project expenditures.
